

Wheels: Ron of Cincinnati writes, “On my 2006 Pontiac Vibe, the tire pressure warning light has been on for most of the last year. I have taken it to the dealer many times and they checked the computer code for it and the computer said all was okay. The dealer reset it, and the light went off. However, two days later it came back on. I had my tires rotated and rebalanced and the tire place checked the pressure and all was okay. Any light you can shed on this? I check the tire pressure once a week and the tires are within the pressure they should be.”

Halderman: Check the air pressure in the spare tire. If it is a full size spare, it too is being monitored by the computer and can light the tire pressure warning lamp.
