_____ 1. Check the service information for the specified brake bleeding procedure for the vehicle being serviced.

_____ 2. Slip the plastic hose over the bleeder screw of the wheel cylinder or caliper to be bled and submerge the end of the tube in the jar of brake fluid.

_____ 3. Open the bleeder screw approximately one-half turn.

_____ 4. With the bleeder screw *open*, have your assistant rapidly pump the brake pedal several times. Air bubbles should come out with the brake fluid.

_____ 5. While your assistant holds the brake pedal to the floor, close the bleeder screw.

_____ 6. Repeat steps 2 through 4 at each bleeder screw in the recommended order.

_____ 7. Re-bleed the system using one of the four other methods described above.
