A dash warning lamp should light whenever the parking brake is applied when the ignition is on. To verify that the parking brake indicator light functions correctly, follow these steps.

\_\_\_\_\_ 1. Turn the ignition to on (run).

**NOTE:** The engine can be started to be sure that the ignition is on.

\_\_\_\_\_ 2. Apply the parking brake (check one of the following).

- \_\_\_ Hand-operated lever
- \_\_\_ Foot-operated pedal
- \_\_\_ Push button-operated parking brake

\_\_\_\_\_ 3. Did the red brake warning light come on?
