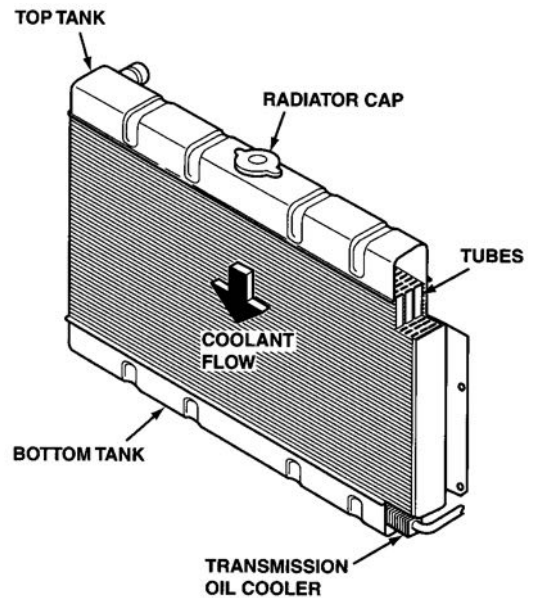
\_\_\_\_\_ 1. Inspect the radiator for exterior leaks or clogged areas due to bugs, dirt, or debris, and clean as required.
