1. Check the service information for the specified brake bleeding procedure for the vehicle being serviced.		
		e wheel cylinder or caliper to be
bled and submerge the end of the tube in the jar of brake fluid.		
3. Open the bleeder screw approximately one-half turn.		
4. With the bleeder screw <i>open</i> , have your assistant rapidly pump the brake pedal several		
times. Air bubbles should c	come out with the bral	ke fluid.
5. While your assistant holds the brake pedal to the floor, close the bleeder screw.		
6. Repeat steps 2 through 4 at each bleeder screw in the recommended order.		
7. Re-bleed the system using one of the four other methods described above.
