 Check service information for the specified procedure for burnishing (breaking-in) new disc brake pads. Describe the specified procedure.

- 2. If a specified burnish procedure is not available, perform the following steps:
 - Step 1 Make 6 to 10 brake applications from approximately 35 mph (56 km/h) with moderate brake pedal force.
 - Step 2 Make an additional two to three hard brake applications from approximately 45 mph (72 km/h).
 - NOTE: Do not allow the vehicle to come to a complete stop. After performing these brake applications, allow the brakes to cool completely before driving again.
