Green (Blue) Symbols - Used to inform the driver what is in operation.

Amber Symbols - Used to inform the driver of a detected concern.

Red Symbols - Used to warn the driver of a fault requiring immediate action by the driver.

Note: Not all vehicles use all of the symbols and some manufacturers may use additional, different colors and/or meanings.
