Wheels: An e-mail from Jack says, "Last spring I bought a 2-seat roadster MX5 and plan to park it for the winter (December, January, and February). I was going to put it up on blocks but somebody told me that it was not good for the bushings in the suspension to let the wheels hang. I had not heard this before and would like your opinion."

Halderman: I can see where someone may be concerned, but when the vehicle is supported under the frame. When the vehicle is supported by the frame, the suspension is in a "full droop" position. However, no harm is done to the suspension bushings because most vehicles are equipped and resting on bump stops so no harm is done. I hope this helps.
