- 3) Bio-diesel is designated with the capital letter "B" followed by the percentage of bio-diesel added to the petroleum-based diesel fuel. B20 indicates that it contains 20% biodiesel. B5 means that it contains 5% biodiesel. Page Ref: 832
- 4) Ultra low sulfur diesel is diesel fuel that contains less than 15 parts per million (ppm) of sulfur or less. Page Ref: 829
- 5) Cloud point is the low-temperature point when the waxes in the diesel fuel tend to form crystals that can clog the fuel filter.
