1. Check service information and state the vehicle manufacturer's procedure for replacing a rotor.

2. Remove the wheel and brake caliper. Support or hang the caliper with wire or a hook.

NOTE: DO NOT allow the caliper to hang by the brake hose.

3. Remove any retainers or fasteners and then remove the rotor.

4. Clean the hub surface and the new rotor, then install the new rotor.

5. Reinstall the caliper and torque the caliper mounting bolts.
